

A "YES" vote authorizes new ski trails and related facilities in the Adirondack forest preserve.  A "NO" vote does not authorize this use.	Should the date of the annual Bronxville Village Election be changed from the third Tuesday in March to the Tuesday next succeeding the first Monday in November each year?  YES means the Election date will change to November, with present office holders' terms extending until November elections.  NO means the election will remain in March.
